Delaration of Interests Policy

1. Introduction

ABC Sports Learning Ltd/Manchester Cycling Academy is committed to maintaining transparency, integrity, and ethical conduct in all operations. This Declaration of Interests Policy outlines the guidelines and expectations for employees and stakeholders to disclose any personal or financial interests that could potentially conflict with the best interests of our organisation.

2. Policy Statement

We recognise the importance of identifying and addressing conflicts of interest to ensure that decisions are made objectively and in the best interest of our students, staff, and stakeholders. This policy aims to:

2.1. Definition of Conflicts of Interest

A conflict of interest arises when an individual's personal, financial, or other interests interfere or could reasonably be perceived to interfere with their ability to make impartial decisions that benefit the institution.

2.2. Transparency and Accountability

All employees, contractors, volunteers, directors, officers, and any other individuals connected to ABC Sports Learning Ltd/Manchester Cycling Academy are expected to disclose any potential conflicts of interest.

2.3. Procedures for Declaration

Individuals with a potential conflict of interest must promptly disclose such interests to their supervisor, manager, or designated contact person.

Disclosure should include the nature of the interest, its potential impact, and any relevant relationships.

2.4. Assessing and Managing Conflicts

Upon receipt of a disclosure, ABC Sports Learning Ltd/Manchester Cycling Academy will assess the potential conflict of interest to determine if it could adversely affect decision-making or create the appearance of impropriety.

2.5. Confidentiality and Non-Retaliation

Disclosures of conflicts of interest will be treated confidentially to the extent possible, while still ensuring the necessary actions are taken. Retaliation against individuals who disclose conflicts of interest in good faith is strictly prohibited.

2.6. Education and Training

Regular training will be provided to employees and relevant stakeholders to raise awareness about conflicts of interest and the importance of disclosure.

2.7. Record Keeping

All disclosed conflicts of interest and related actions taken will be documented for transparency and accountability purposes.

3. Reporting

A summary of the actions taken to implement and enforce this policy will be included in our annual reports and made available to stakeholders.

4. Review

Adherence to this policy is mandatory for all individuals associated with ABC Sports Learning Ltd/Manchester Cycling Academy. Any failure to disclose conflicts of interest may result in disciplinary action.
